## **House rules**

#### Safe-Space

§ 1 In order to make KUBŌ22 a successful and memorable festival for everyone, we ask you to follow the house rules. We understand KUBŌ22 as a safe space, where visitors and all participants should feel comfortable. All types of discrimination have no place here. We ask you to treat each other respectfully. Furthermore, political propaganda and actions are forbidden.

#### **Admission**

- § 2 The KUBO22 staff are identified by KUBO T-shirts. The instructions of these persons must be followed. Disturbance of the event may result in a charge under §285 StGB.
- § 3 An entrance fee must be paid to attend the event. The fee is determined by the organizers and is not negotiable. Upon payment of the admission fee, visitors will receive admission wristbands or a three-day festival pass. These admission wristbands have consecutive numbers for control purposes and are color-coded according to ticket and day. The admission wristbands and the festival pass (black admission wristband) must be worn visibly on the wrist.
- § 4 The organizers have the right to exclude persons from the event who violate the house rules, cause a nuisance to other visitors, become verbally and/or physically violent or disturb the event. There is no right to a refund of a paid admission fee.
- § 5 The festival will take place at the VHS Großfeldsiedlung, Kürschnergasse 9 exclusively on the ground floor. Visitors are only allowed to enter the designated event areas. This includes the foyer, the hall, the large hall, two workshop rooms and the parking lot. The backstage area, the artists' dressing rooms, the back office, the storage room and the entire first floor of the VHS may not be entered.

#### **Image & Sound Recordings**

- § 6 Taking photos and/or video recordings at the event is generally permitted until revoked, except recordings in sanitary facilities and changing rooms without the prior knowledge of the person being recorded. Visitors accept that it is possible that photographs and/or video recordings may be made of them during the event and that these may be published by Sentro for marketing or documentation purposes only. There is no entitlement to payment for this, nor is there any right to object to publication.
- § 7 For the production of image and/or sound recordings for press activities (as well as for any other type of intended press activity), a press agreement (request under contact) must be filled out completely and with correct information, signed and sent to the event manager (or a designated person via contact) and approved.

## Ban on pets

§ 8 Animals are not permitted to be brought along. Assistance dogs (signal, service and guide dogs for the blind) are excluded.

# Prohibition of weapons & handling of open fire

§ 9 Weapons: Bringing weapons of any kind is prohibited for the entire event area and event period.

This includes:	
	Real firearms and real ammunition
	Soft Air weapons (including those that have been rendered unusable)
	Gas pistols (also unloaded)
	Imitation firearms made of metal and wood or other materials
	Pyrotechnics
	Throwing weapons (knives, stars, arrows)
	Brass knuckles, manslayers, steel rods
	Strangle weapons (garottes, nunchucks)
	Stabbing weapons (knives, hatchets, axes, morning stars, swords)
	Stabbing weapons with blade replacements made of plastic, resin or wood
	Staffs made of wood, metal, fiberglass, hard plastic, or combinations of the foregoing, if made only of these materials or combinations thereof. (e.g., kendo swords, boken, bamboo swords)
	Arrows of any kind with arrowheads
	Riding crops over 1 meter in length, whips with a total length of 1.5 meters, staff whips if the staff is longer than 1 meter and the whip as a whole is longer than 1.5 meters
	Private protective items such as CS gas, pepper sprays or the like
	Weapons that look like everyday items (cane swords, belt buckle knives, etc.)
	Loose metal chains and so-called tanto knives
	Tools, knives, scissors or pocket knives
	O Carrying other sharp and blunt objects that can endanger people, more specifically the use of y object as a weapon is strictly prohibited and they must be handed in at the gate.
	1 Excluded from the restrictions of § 9 and § 10 are all persons authorized by the organizer for the rose (e.g.: martial arts demonstrators) and members of the Austrian executive on duty.

- § 12 Handling of open fire (lighters, candles, burning pastes, etc.) is prohibited during the entire festival period and on the festival grounds.

### Prohibition of consumption of addictive substances & alcohol as well as smoking ban

- § 13 The carrying, consumption or passing on of addictive substances in accordance with Art. 1 of the Narcotic Substances Act is prohibited. The organizers are obliged to report any violation. Persons who possess addictive substances at the event will also be excluded from the event in accordance with § 3 of the house rules.
- § 14 The consumption of tobacco products, e-cigarettes and the like (including vapor products) as well as the distribution of alcoholic food and beverages to minors is prohibited during the entire festival period and on the festival grounds.
- § 15 Any inventory, furnishings, walls, windows, etc. must not be damaged. The person causing the damage is liable for it.

#### **Consumption of food and beverages**

- § 16 The consumption of food and beverages is prohibited in the exhibition area.
- § 17 Consumption of all kinds of beverages and food brought in is not permitted.

#### Wardrobe & lost property

- § 18 Large bags and backpacks, as well as umbrellas, must be left at the wardrobe.
- § 19 Canes and other walking aids (e.g. rollator) may only be taken by infirm persons as an indispensable support.
- § 20 Lost or found objects may be handed in at the wardrobe and collected there.

### **Noise restrictions**

§ 21 From 10 p.m. onwards, residents must not be disturbed by loud noise or music.

### Waste disposal, cleaning & sanitary facilities


- § 22 The festival area must be kept clean during the entire festival period. Garbage must be disposed of in the garbage cans and/or waste bins etc. provided for this purpose and separated accordingly. At the subway station as well as at the post office there are larger trash containers for plastic, metal and glass waste.
- § 24 At the festival area there are two sanitary facilities for visitors, each with a barrier-free toilet for persons with reduced mobility.

### Accessibility for people with reduced mobility

- § 25 The festival takes place on the ground floor and at the parking lot of the VHS. All public rooms and the parking lot are accessible to people with reduced mobility.
- § 26 The VHS has in total 2 toilets for people with reduced mobility.


### **Behavior in emergencies**

§ 27 All doors in the VHS are emergency exits. Escape routes and every exit must be kept clear at all times and must not be obstructed. The VHS parking lot serves as an access road for all emergency personnel and must not be blocked for them.




§ 28 In case of an emergency, we ask you to leave the area via the emergency exits and to gather at the assembly point located in front of the exit of the subway station Großfeldsiedlung. We ask you to always remain calm under all circumstances.

§ 29 In the event of a fire, the KUBO22 staff must be contacted immediately. The supervisor will then contact the fire department and the responsible VHS technician. We ask you to follow the instructions of all emergency personnel and to remain calm.

§ 30 There are 5 fire extinguishers on the ground floor of the VHS Großfeldsiedlung, which are shown on the following map.



§ 31 In case of medical emergencies, the KUBO22 staff must be informed immediately. The supervisor will contact the rescue, the medical staff on site and the house technician who has access to the first aid boxes.

§ 32 In case of danger, immediately inform KUBO22 staff. The supervisor in turn will contact the police and the responsible house technician of the VHS. We ask you to follow the instructions of all emergency personnel and to remain calm.
